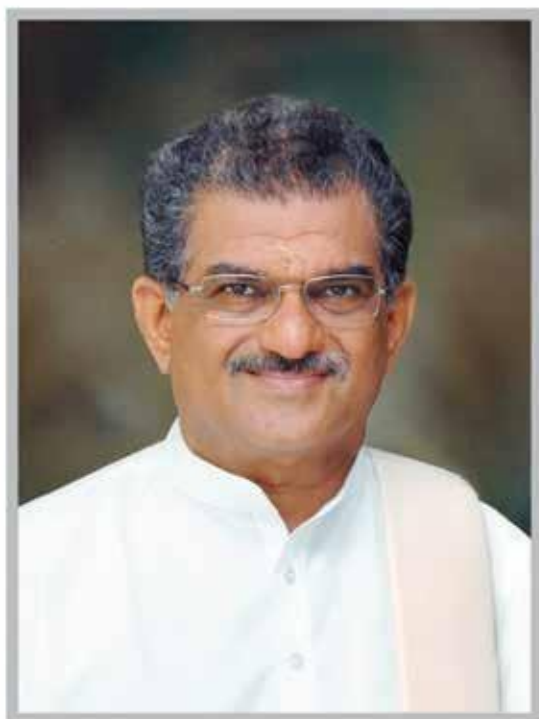

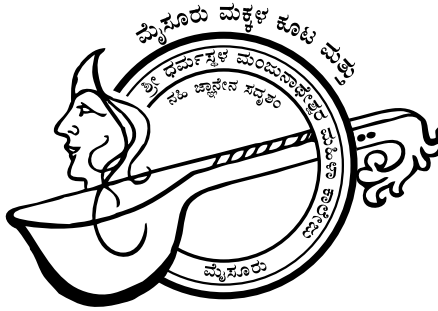

Rules and Regulations

- 4 Students who arrive before the first bell should engage themselves usefully in the class room or library. They should not waste their time. During the leisure hours students should not roam in the college campus and should not go out of the college campus unless there is absolute necessity
- 5 Student should be within the lecture hall or laboratory soon after the first bell.
- 6 Disobedience, either in speech or in action is liable to be punished by suspension or dismissal from the college
- 7 Students requests will be attended during 9.30-10.00 am, 1.00-to 1.30p.m & 3.30to 5.00 p.m. in the office.
- 8 Any damage done to the college property is punishable by fine.
- 9 In order to safeguard and promote its ideals regarding the character and personal behavior of the students the college reserves the right to take necessary action.
- 10 Students are forbidden from organizing or attending any meeting in the College, except those of college activities or to collect money for any purpose or to circulate among the students. Any notice or petition of any kind or to exhibit notices or posters of any kind anywhere in the college campus **without the prior permission of the Principal.**
- 11 Students must not take part in political agitation directed against the Authority of University/Government or take an active part in politics.
- 12 Group deputations, appeals or demonstrations of any kind are strictly Prohibited.
- 13 Students should keep the college area clean. They should desist from writing anything on the desks, blackboard or the

walls they should not throw pieces of paper inside the class room. Dustbins are provided and they should make use of them.

- 14 The students who come by their own vehicles, should park their vehicles at the appropriate place as per the guidelines of the college Authorities. They must comply the Traffic Rules.
- 15 The college does not take any responsibility in regard to the safety of vehicles parked in the campus.
- 16 Serious misconduct within the college premises is sufficient reason for Dismissal.
- 17 Attendance at college functions and co-curricular activities is obligatory to all students.
- 18 No tours, excursions, picnics or pleasure trips are to be arranged organized without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 19 Students should bring their Identity card and leave record daily when they come to the college. Any student who fails to produce her identity card/leave record whenever demanded by lecture or Principal is punishable with fine.
20. Students should bring their Identity card and admission ticket when they come for Annual Exams, University Exams, failing which they will not be permitted to take the exams.
- 21 Students when in college premises are expected to be neatly and modestly dressed in accordance with the approved etiquette.
- 22 Admission to this college is conditional. Hence, compulsory compliance is solicited.

Library Rules and Regulations

- 1 Library will be kept open from 9.00 am to 5.00 p.m. on all the working days except Saturday(Saturday 9.00 a.m. to 2p.m)
- 2 Strict silence should be observed in the library.
- 3 Students can borrow the books regularly & return it on time.
- 4 Books for home reading may as a general rule be kept for 14 days. Extension may be granted if the book has not been demanded by another member of the library and the new due date will be made known to the borrower on the due date slip. However, it is necessary to produce the book at the library counter at the time of application of extension.
- 5 The borrowed book should be returned on or before the date specified in the book. If she fails to return the book within the stipulated period overdue charges will be collected as below:

First 10 days	-	Rs 10
20 days	-	Rs. 30
30 days	-	Rs.60
After 30 days	-	Rs.120

After 60 days if the student fails to return the books/membership will be cancelled.
- 6 Dictionaries and Encyclopedias and rare books will not be lent out.
- 7 A reader who wants to consult a book or magazine in the library may do so.

- 8 A students to whom a book is issued will be held responsible for the safe and timely return of the book without any damage. She must not write anything or make any mark on it.
- 9 Identity card and borrowers tickets are not transferable. These cards must be surrendered to the library at the end of the academic year or when leaving the institution.
- 10 Students should carry their identity card when they go to library, Laboratories examination hall and the college office. They should show their identity cards to the lecturer in the class room if demanded. If lost, a duplicate card will be issued on payment of fee of Rs.50/-Likewise, duplicate borrower card will be issued on payment of fee of Rs.50/-.
- 11 Economically backward students can avail text books from the college book bank.
- 12 The student has to complete 25 hours of compulsory library reference per semester. Hall tickets will not be issued to the students who fail to complete the same.
