Attendance and Leave

1. Punctual and regular attendance is necessary. Attendance will be marked individually for every subject at the beginning of each period. Students with less than 75% attendance in each individual subject are not eligible to appear for the public examinations according to rules.
2. Attendance is compulsory for all the college examinations, tests and on the re-opening days after holidays is compulsory. When a student is not able to attend a test or an examination owing to valid reasons such as ill-health the absence should be recorded in the leave application form and signed by the parent. Leave application form should then be submitted to the academic Advisor/Principal.
3. Application for leave should be made in advance. When absence is due to unforeseen reasons, application for leave should be submitted immediately on the day of return.
4. Sick-leave application must be accompanied by a medical certificate.
5. The leave application form wherein leave is taken during the year are recorded, should be submitted without fail at the time of receiving admission tickets for the annual exams.

Discipline

1. Students should keep in touch with the day-to-day activities of the college. They should regularly look in to the notice-board for notices, announcements etc.,
2. In case of any difficulty, students should consult their lecturers who will guide and help them.
3. Students should strictly follow the rules and regulations of the college.
4. Students who arrive before the first bell should engage themselves usefully in the class room or library. They should not waste their time. During the leisure hours students should not roam about the college campus and should not go out of the college campus unless there is absolute necessity.
5. Students should be within the lecture hall or laboratory soon after the first bell.
6. They should maintain strict silence and discipline in the class room. Disobedience, either in speech or in action is liable to be punished by suspension or dismissal from the college.
7. Students requests will be attended to during 9-30 to 10-00 a.m., 1-00 to 1-30 p.m. & 3-30 p.m. to 5-00 p.m. in the office.
8. Any damage done to the college property is punishable by fine.
9. In order to safeguard and promote its ideals regarding the character and personal behaviour of the students the college reserves the right to take necessary action.

10. Students are forbidden from organizing or attending any meeting in the college except those of college activities or to collect money for any purpose or to circulate among the students any notice or petition of any kind or to exhibit notices or posters of any kind any where in the college campus without the previous permission of the Principal.
11. Students must not take part in political agitation directed against the authority of Government or take an active part in politics.
12. Group deputations, appeals or demonstrations of any kind are strictly prohibited.
13. Students should keep the area clean. They should desist from writing anything on the desks, blackboard or on the walls. They should not throw pieces of paper inside the class room. Dustbins are provided and they should make use of them.
14. The students who come by their own vehicles, should park their vehicles at the appropriate place as per the guidance of the security person.
15. The college does not take any responsibility with regard to the safety of the vehicles parked in the campus.
16. Serious misconduct within the college premises is sufficient reason for dismissal.
17. Attendance at college functions and cocurricular activities is obligatory to all students.
18. No tours, excursions, picnics or pleasure trips are to be arranged or organized without the prior permission of the Principal.

19. Students should bring their identity card and leave record daily when they come to the college. Any student who fails to produce her identity card/leave record whenever demanded by lecturer or Principal is punishable with fine.
20. Students should bring their Identity Card and admission ticket when they come for Annual Exams, PUE Board, University Exams, failing which they will not be permitted to take the exams.
21. Students when in college premises are expected to be neatly and modestly dressed in accordance with the approved etiquette. Skin tight dresses and miniskirts are strictly prohibited.
22. Carrying of Cellphone inside the college is strictly prohibited.
23. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Offenders will be seriously dealt with.

Library Rules and Regulations

1. Library will be kept open from 9-00 a.m. to 5-00 p.m. on all working days except Saturdays (Saturday 9-00 a.m. to 1-00 p.m.)
2. Strict silence should be observed in the library.
3. Books will be issued as per the time table to be announced.
4. Books will be issued once in a week.
5. Books for home reading may as a general rule be kept for 14 days. Extension may be granted if the book has not been demanded by another member of the library and the new due date will be made known to the borrower on the date slip.

However, it is necessary to produce the book at the library counter at the time of application of extension.

6. A reader will have to pay a fine of Rs. 1-00 per day per book if she fails to return the book within the stipulated period. Fines would increase progressively with each case of default.
7. Reference book (Such as dictionaries and Encyclopedias) and rare books will not be lent out.
8. A reader who wants to consult a book or a magazine in the library may do so.
9. A student to whom a book has been issued will be held responsible for the safe and timely return of the book without any damage. She must not write anything or make any mark on it.

Before leaving the counter she should examine the book and bring to the notice of the librarian any damage found in it.

10. Membership and Reference cards are not transferable. These cards must be surrendered to the library at the end of the academic year or when leaving the institution.
11. Students should have their identity cards when they go to the library, laboratories, examination hall and the college office. They should be ready to show their identity cards to the lecturer in the class room if demanded. If lost a duplicate card will be issued on payment of fee of Rs. 30 (for a Borrowers card also such fine is Rs. 30)
12. Economically backward students can avail text books from the College book bank.

TO STUDENTS

- 1) We are proud that you are a student of MMK & SDM College an esteemed institution of Mysore.
- 2) Students are required to come to the college at least ten minutes before the starting time. They should be punctual to the class and try to have 100% attendance; shortage of attendance will be viewed very seriously.
- 3) The students should take extreme care to maintain cleanliness in the classroom and campus. Stringent action will be taken against the offenders who deface furniture or walls.
- 4) Students are required to maintain the dignity and decorum of the college through out their stay.
- 5) The students are expected to come to the college neatly dressed. **It is mandatory for the girls to wear only uniform / chudidars.** Skirttight dresses are strictly prohibited.
- 6) The students should not leave the college premises during the college hours without prior permission from the institution/ class teacher.
- 7) No student should be seen on corridors or premises during class hours. Students with free hours shall retire to the reading room/library.
- 8) The students should take care of their text books, notes books and library books throughout the year.
- 9) The students are free and welcome to meet the teachers in case of any difficulty.
- 10) Students are expected to participate in the co-curricular activities arranged by the college, which is very essential for the overall development of their personality.
- 11) Students are directed to see the notice boards regularly as important information are displayed on it.
- 12) It is mandatory on the part of the students to attend all the tests and examinations, absenting from the test or examination without valid reasons will be viewed seriously.
- 13) Completion of laboratory records etc. on time as directed, is mandatory.
- 14) **Use of Mobile phones in the college is prohibited.**
- 15) Every student is required to undergo medical checkup arranged by the college every year.
