It has been decided to conduct the Shrimati Lakshminagaraju Memorial Inter-College Classical Music Competition, which has been organized by the college on Wednesday, 27-09-2023 at 9.30 am. - We request you to send your students to participate in the competition and encourage them. The rules and regulations are given below. You are requested to attend the prize distribution ceremony after the competition.

Competition Rules.

- Only students who are studying full-time in diploma, undergraduate or degree colleges (including medical, engineering colleges) affiliated to Mysore university are eligible to participate in the competition.
- Maximum four students from each college can participate.
- The age of such students should not exceed 25 years as on 27-09-2023.
- Only Carnatic classical singing is allowed in the competition.
- Contestants must practice raga and vocal imagination with a classical work.
- Duration: The competition must not exceed 10 minutes
- Candidates must bring their own tambourine / sruthipettige / electric / electronic instrument
- Contestants must be present at the competition venue half an hour before the competition starts.
- The last date for registration of names to participate in the competition is 25-09-2023.
- No travel allowance will be given to the contestants.
- The entry fee for the contestants is fixed at a nominal Rs. 50.00.
- The decision of the judges in the competition is final.
- Any changes in the competition can be made by the organizers.
- The details of the cash prizes are as follows
- First Prize - 2000, Second Prize - 1500 and Third Prize - 1000
- Consolation Prize - 750 (In case two contestants win the prize, the cash money will be shared equally)
