I strongly believe that all of us should be extremely proud to belong to this institution. As all of you know very recently the Prime Minister of the country himself took a personal interest in the nomination of Poojya Heggadeji to the Indian Parliament. This is a testimony from the Prime Minister himself to the outstanding contributions being made by Poojya Heggadeji in the field of education, spirituality, and social service. Poojya Heggadeji has been able to make tremendous contributions. Thanks to the able administrators and visionaries. His brother Sri D. Surendra Kumar, The Vice president of our institution has been a major pillar of strength for Poojya Heggadeji from the beginning especially in building excellent educational institutions. Today we are blessed to have him here with us and I thank him for accepting our invitation to grace the occasion and address our students who are about to start another new chapter in their lives.

Mysore Makkala Koota, an NGO working on women and children established this institution in the year 1990 with 13 students in B.Sc Programme affiliated to Mysore university in the year 1992. The college was handed over to SDME Society ®, Ujire and has later become MMK SDM Mahila Mahavidyalaya and is completing 30 years of its takeover. In these years, the college has grown by leaps and bounds and it has got 1026 students in B.Sc., B.com, BBA, and BCA programs. The Post Graduate Commerce also added to the growth story. Of course, on campus, we have got another 900 students in PUC which has got a separate entity making the total strength of the campus almost 2000.

Both the colleges have three storied buildings and other infrastructure in an area of 2.22 acres and very particularly MMV has been growing vertically by introducing add-on courses, and new programs including PG programs. At the same time, adding necessary and sophisticated Equipment, Machinery, ICT tools, etc., for basic studies, research, and special innovation and incubation activities. The academic and non-academic activities are carried out under the able guidance of 47 full-time and 5 part-time teachers and 25 non-teaching staff.
