1. INTRODUCTION:-

MMK & SDM Mahila Mahavidyalaya in association with Mysore Makkala koota Organized awareness program about Pulse Polio. The Pulse Polio is an immunization campaign established by the government of India to eliminate poliomyelitis (polio) in India by vaccinating all children under the age of five years against the polio virus. The project fights polio through a large-scale, pulse vaccination programme and monitoring for poliomyelitis cases.

2. OBJECTIVE:

The Pulse Polio Initiative was started with an objective of achieving hundred per cent coverage under Oral Polio Vaccine. It aimed to immunize children through improved social mobilization, plan mop-up operations in areas where poliovirus has almost disappeared and maintain high level of morale among the public.

3. PROCEEDINGS OF THE PROGRAM

- Information Dissemination: The program began with informative sessions that highlighted the impact of poliomyelitis and the significance of the Pulse Polio immunization campaign.
- Outreach Campaign: Volunteers and organizers conducted an outreach campaign to reach communities and inform them about the vaccination drive.
- Door-to-Door Awareness: Teams visited households in the targeted areas to explain the benefits of the Pulse Polio vaccination and answer queries from parents and caregivers.
- Mobile Health Units: Mobile health units were deployed to provide on-the-spot vaccinations for children under five years of age.


